INTRODUCTION

Embark on the last exploration - to Antarctica, the White Continent. Spend a pre cruise night within the cosmopolitan metropolis of Buenos Aires, birthplace of the Tango. Flights are covered to/from Ushuaia. Here you will embark your expedition ship, Seabourn Pursuit.

The Seabourn Pursuit takes up to 264 passengers and has 136 all-balcony suites onboard. You will cruise in ultimate luxury and can make use of facilities, including a pool, sauna, spa and fitness centre onboard. There is 5 Michelin level dining venues onboard the ship and in suite dining and minibar are included in your fare.

Enjoy a tailor-made experience in Antarctica, with landings and excursion handpicked to allow for optimal weather conditions and wildlife spotting. The highly experienced expedition team will make sure you enjoy a variety of activities, including landings on the peninsula, hiking and zodiac rides. The ship comes equipped with two custom built submarines and underwater excursions can be pre-booked on selected departures. *additional cost applies.

Spot tabular icebergs and pack ice as you cruise through the pristine waters and look out for the multiple species of penguins, whales and seals that call this harsh environment home.

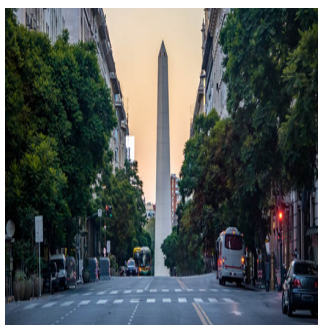

DAY 1: Arrive Buenos Aires

Referred to as the 'Paris of South America', Buenos Aires is considered as one of the most livable cities in South America. Although the bustling capital city has just under 3,000,000 inhabitants and a population density of 13,680 inhabitants per square kilometer (34,800 per square mile), it was rated in 2018 as one of the top cities on the continent for its 'quality of life'. Twinned with world cities such as Moscow and Miami, Buenos Aires displays through its architecture, a cultural past rooted in both the Old and New Worlds. A vibrancy for life can be seen everywhere. Crowded public markets, street performers dancing the tango, colorful graffiti-style street art, ultra-modern buildings, a dramatic skyline and a bustling port. Culturally, Buenos Aires has the busiest live theatre industry on Earth, outperforming New York, London and Paris. Every weekend, over 300 theatres are active with plays and productions. *Please note: Cruise itinerary is subject to change depending on weather conditions, ice conditions and other factors.



DAY 2: Fly to Ushuaia & Embarkation

Start your day by flying from Buenos Aires to Ushuaia. Upon landing, our team will be ready to pick you up at the airport and ensure a seamless transfer to the ship for embarkation. Once deemed too harsh for European settlement, Ushuaia's rugged beauty was the realm of its native inhabitants - the Yahgan People. Today, it holds the distinctive title of being the southernmost city on Earth, often referred to as 'the end of the world.' Situated along the banks of the Beagle Channel, Ushuaia unveils itself like an artist's masterpiece. A mosaic of vibrant houses adds a splash of color against the dramatic backdrop of snow-capped mountains. Dominating this breathtaking panorama is Monte Olivia, its jagged peaks soaring 4,530 feet above the landscape.

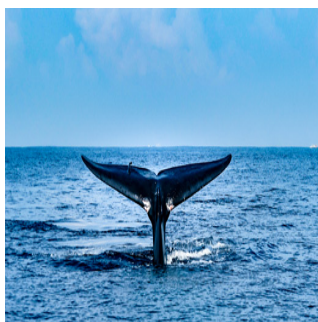
DAY 5: Antarctica Exploration - Day 5 to 11

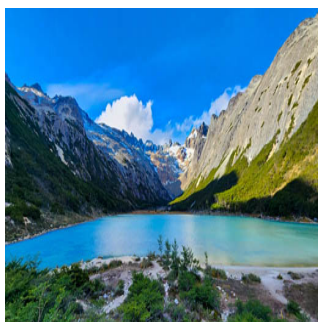
DAY 12: At Sea - Day 12 & 13
